Class B External Loads	Class B is an external cargo load that can be jettisoned and is lifted free of land and/or water by a cargo hook or winch. An example of a class B load operation would be the placement of an air conditioning unit on the roof of a tall building, or a trapeze act.
Class C External Loads	Class C is an external cargo load which can be jettisoned and remains in contact with land or water. An example is a wire stringing operation at a construction project.
