Applicability

Term	Definition
Home Base	The Primary Business Address as stated in template A001 for the agricultural aircraft operations certificate holder.
Hopper	Container within the airplane structure to hold the aerially dispensed products.
Spray Boom	Length of pipe or tubing of variable size or shape, depending upon the system and the particular application. The operation of an aircraft for the purpose of (1) dispensing any economic poison, (2) dispensing any other substance intended for plant nourishment, soil treatment, propagation of plant life, or pest control, or (3) engaging in dispensing activities directly affecting agriculture, horticulture, or forest preservation, but not including the dispensing of live insects.
Spreader	Systems attached to the fixed points of the airplane, under the hopper, including the associated gatebox, which dispense dry agricultural chemicals and seed.
